Central Connecticut State University is an AA/EQ institution and a campus of the Connecticut State University System.

In the autumn of every year, the people of Poland and those of Polish heritage around the globe gather for community-wide celebrations known as Dozynki. The traditional Dozynki, rooted in centuries-old Polish tradition, celebrates the end of the farming season; a Dozynki festival is a grand, community affair, a time when farmers gather with servants, farm workers and townspeople to reap the reward of a bountiful harvest.

In New Britain — a well-documented, Polish American stronghold in the Northeast — CCSU today is in many ways quietly but excitedly celebrating its own Dozynki. It is reaping the reward of a different kind of bounty, a bounty sowed by decades of work and dedication to build the University's very first endowed chair, the Stanislaus A. Blejwas Endowed Chair in Polish and Polish American Studies.

CCSU's Blejwas Endowed Chair, held by renowned scholar Dr. Mieczyslaw B. Biskupski, and the Polish and Polish American Studies program have entered a new phase of maturity since the program's founding more than 30 years ago, and are currently engaged in a variety of exciting, landmark initiatives. If the Chair had not already put the University on American academia's national map, then it is surely there today.

"There are probably only a handful of universities in the country that have programming of this nature,"

says Nicholas Pettinico, Jr., the University's vice president for institutional advancement.

"Harvard is one of them. So it's fabulous for Central to be in that league, to be considered a peer institution with respect to this program."

The analogy to the Polish Dozynki festival is an apt one, for CCSU's Endowed Chair in Polish and Polish American Studies is not only a reflection of its community, but was built, in a sense, on sweat equity. In fact, unlike most academic endowments of this nature — traditionally established at major, private universities with access to a stable of wealthy benefactors — funding for this chair was a true grass roots effort supported by members of Greater Hartford's Polish community and others, and engaged in over a period of more than 20 years.

And the leader of this grass roots effort was Stan Blejwas.

Blejwas was CCSU's first professor of Polish and Polish American Studies. He arrived at Central in 1974, after having completed his doctorate in modern East European and Polish history at Columbia University and serving briefly as the assistant director of Columbia's Institute on East Central Europe.

The young Blejwas was selected by a search committee tasked with establishing a Polish Studies program at CCSU. It was all part of a wide-ranging effort by prominent members of Connecticut's Polish American community to commemorate, in 1973, the 500th anniversary of the birth of Polish astronomer and mathematician Nicolaus Copernicus. The effort bore fruit in a variety of ways — including the naming of Copernicus Hall and the Copernican Planetarium and Observatory on campus — but more significantly with the procurement of \$50,000 in seed money from the State of Connecticut General Assembly to establish a Polish and Polish American Studies program at CCSU.

Over some 20 years Blejwas, who became widely published and built an enviable record of academic distinction as a highly sought-after authority on Polish history and heritage, worked at building the program. In the mid-1990s, when the General Assembly offered matching grants for program development to the state's public colleges and universities, the Endowed Chair in Polish and Polish American Studies was born. Naturally, Blejwas was selected to occupy it.

the Art of "Polishness"

Fostering appreciation and understanding of Polish culture is a hallmark of CCSU's Stanislaus A. Blejwas Endowed Chair in Polish and Polish American Studies. There is perhaps no better example of this mission than a recent exhibit at Hartford's Real Art Ways gallery.



CCSU's Polish Studies program partnered with the respected alternative gallery to present "POZA," a multi-faceted program of Polish art, films, lectures, multi-media and more. Curated by Polish-born and New York-based art critic and historian Marek Bartelik, POZA gathered the works of 31 artists with roots directly or indirectly in Poland and who currently live in Poland, the United States, Canada,

France and Brazil. The artists represented different generations; the oldest born in the 1930s, the youngest in the 1980s. Works included painting, sculpture, photography, new media, video and site-specific installations and performances.

Central to the exhibit was the notion of "Polishness" as a matter of choice and awareness rather than specific geography or place of birth. "The art is interpreted as an expression of enhanced evanescence in a politicized environment that encourages both nationalism and globalism," said Bartelik.

a specialist in Polish American history and retired professor of psychiatry who helped lead the effort to establish the program. "The seed money was a start, and Blejwas was the one who made it all happen."

Sadly, no sooner had Blejwas realized his dream when he passed away unexpectedly at age 59 in 2001.

Enter Biskupski, who arrived in the fall of 2002 from St. John Fisher College in Rochester, N.Y., following a year-long search for Blejwas' successor. Biskupski's acceptance of the Blejwas Endowed Chair was a coup for CCSU, as he is a prolific author, researcher and international speaker, widely regarded as one of America's premier authorities on Polish history.

The program offers CCSU students, visiting scholars and the community at large a rich combination of academic coursework, historical archives, cultural programming and special events that is truly unique in American higher education.

Biskupski earned his undergraduate degree at UCLA, where he was awarded a Yale Fellowship, and ultimately spent nine years in New Haven, teaching and earning his doctorate. He has served as a Fulbright Research Professor at the University of Warsaw and, in 1997, was a fellow of the Central European University of Budapest.

Today's Polish and Polish American Studies program at CCSU is a reflection of the vision and grass roots foundation laid by Blejwas, and the present-day scholarship and influence of Biskupski. The program offers CCSU students, visiting scholars and the community at large a rich combination of academic coursework, historical archives, cultural programming and special events that is truly unique in American higher education.

As part of the Department of History, the program offers a variety of courses in Polish history, culture, politics, civilization, language and the Polish community in America. Additional program-related resources include the Polish Heritage Book Collection, which houses some 25,000 catalogued books and periodicals to supplement course offerings, and the Connecticut Polish American Archive, a research depository open to the public, scholars and students of the Polish community in America. Both are located at Elihu Burritt Library.

Regular programming includes the annual Fiedorczyk Lecture in Polish American Studies; the annual Milewski Lecture in Polish Studies; the biennial Godlewski Evening of Polish Culture; the Koproski Lecture on Polish Business and Economy Series; and the Rudewicz Evening of Polish Music. Noted politicians, scholars and artists ranging from Lech Walesa and former Polish ambassador Dr. Przemyslaw Grudzinski, to Yale scholar Piotr Wandycz, to Polish composer Krzysztof Penderecki, along with many others, have all visited the CCSU campus.





"J.B.'s" INFLUENCE LIVES ON

Humor, particularly that of the satirical variety, was always the tool of preference in the classroom of Justus Beach, the long-retired and beloved CCSU professor of teacher education who, now 86 years of age, still maintains close ties to the university with which he has been associated for nearly 70 years.

Perhaps no story better captures the essence of "J.B." — as he is affectionately known — than one of his favorite tales from "The Saber-Tooth Curriculum," which was text de rigueur in his classroom. The book is a 1939 satirical reflection upon the educational establishment. The story goes something like this:



A staid college professor enters a tourist bar in Tijuana, Mexico that claims to be the longest in the world. A firm believer in the science of education and the testing of hypotheses (and certified teetotaler, to boot), the professor demands to know how the bar can claim to be the longest in the world in the absence of scientific measurement.

"What is needed in the Tijuana-tourist educational system is an increase in careful measurement and a decrease in fantastic humbug!" proclaims the professor.

A former student who happens to be in the bar, enlightened by a life of world travel since his college days (not to mention the four "Tequila Daisies" he has just consumed), takes issue with the professor's rigid stance, pointing out the "potentially important social purpose served by this (untested) hypothesis."

And just what might that purpose be? "The integration of the human personality," proudly states the student.


The "human personality" and its role in education has long held a special place in the heart of J.B., a true CCSU original.

"The moral of that (Tijuana) story is that in education, life is the curriculum," says former student David Barrett '80. "It opened up our minds to the fact that there is more than one way to teach; I still use that theory today."

J.B. spent 30 years at CCSU opening minds, blazing trails and rattling cages (though gently), all in the interest of enlightening, inspiring and motivating young teachers-to-be. "He was very, very popular because he was so creative in his approach," says colleague and Associate Professor, Emeritus Marilyn Hott MS '74, former chair of the Teacher Education Department.

A 1943 graduate of the then-Teacher's College of Connecticut, J.B. joined CCSU in 1960. A New Britain native who still lives in the same Osgood Avenue farmhouse that his ancestors acquired in 1779, J.B. retired in 1989. Centuries ago, his ancestors walked the very farmland upon which CCSU would be built.

"Students loved being in J.B.'s class and the atmosphere was electric," says Anthony Rigazio-Digilio, current chair of the Department of Educational Leadership. "He wanted all students to be successful and part of the process – there was never a student marginalized in J.B.'s classroom."

Barrett, who remains close to J.B. today, recalls the learning "marathons" that J.B. used to coordinate at the Student Center. "They were typical J.B.; anything went. For two or three days, students would make presentations about anything in the world. It was exciting, stimulating."

"It was like a mini-educational Mardi Gras," laughs Rigazio-Digilio. "They were very cutting edge."

In addition to teaching, J.B. was a leader in Connecticut's formal development of alternative schools, and to this day serves as a consultant to the Connecticut Association of Alternative Schools and Programs.

Today's students continue to reap the benefit of J.B.'s influence. The Justus Beach Scholarship assists students of economically and educationally disadvantaged backgrounds enrolled in one of the University's teacher preparation programs.

For his part, J.B. looks back fondly, but modestly, on his career.

"I think teaching is very important," he says matter-of-factly. "A teacher is in a unique position to shape the next generation."

"I just had a great time every day." ☐





As Biskupski explains it, the Endowed Chair, program and University are all heavily committed to most any worthwhile endeavor to advance a greater understanding and awareness of Polish and Polish American history, culture and its place in the world.

"If there is something happening in this country relative to Polish studies, we want to be involved with it. If there are books being published, we want to help," he says. "If there is a major academic or cultural initiative regarding Poland and its people, we will support it."

"The message here is that CCSU is committed to being a major player in this arena."

Under Biskupski's leadership, the Polish and Polish American Studies program is engaged in several groundbreaking initiatives. Biskupski has already played an instrumental role in locating the headquarters of the Polish American Historical Association on the CCSU campus. In addition, he and members of the program's advisory board — a group of regional business, education and community leaders including CCSU administration — are in the midst of planning a permanent, major exhibit at the New England Air Museum in Windsor Locks honoring members of the Kosciuszko Squadron, a Polish-manned fighter squadron that teamed with Great Britain during World War II and claimed the highest number of enemy kills against Nazi Germany during the Battle of Britain.

But perhaps the most significant initiative that the Chair is currently involved with is a long-range plan to establish a Polish ethnographic museum and genealogical center at the University. According to Biskupski, CCSU stands to receive a massive collection of outstanding Polish folk art, including paintings, wood carvings, tapestries and more, from a local benefactor who has willed the collection to CCSU.

"Certainly, genealogy and heritage today are of universal appeal, and we are in a unique position here, with our history and our current archives and the collection we are in line to receive, to create something special," says Waldemar Kostrzewa '68, MS '74, chair of the Polish and Polish American Studies Advisory Board. "The pieces are all in place. But we need a central locus for this; we need to move it from paper and concept to reality."

"All of these efforts are really in their initial stages now," adds Biskupski. "I consider one of my major goals to be finding the space, building the space, acquiring the space to create this museum and genealogical center. There is nothing like it in the country. This, as you would imagine, is not an inexpensive undertaking."

"My predecessor created virtually everything we have here now. The task is to take this to another level," he concludes. "When I leave here, I would like to leave a place for my successor to be, a place where anyone can come and know that this is the home of Polish studies and history at CCSU. I think that kind of palpable reality will do a great deal toward furthering the stature of the program and this institution."

The seeds of success continue to be sowed. Stan Blejwas would be proud. **G**

Campus Obituaries

Dr. Joseph R. Dunn, Jr. '50, director of research, emeritus, died August 23, 2006. Prior to joining CCSU, Dunn was employed by the North Haven Public School system and the Hamden Hall Country Day School. He was a World War II veteran who served in the Pacific Theater.

Jeanne H. Heckler, assistant professor of education, emerita, died October 15, 2006, at the age of 94. Heckler spent more than 40 years at Vance Elementary School in New Britain training student teachers from Central Connecticut State College, now CCSU.

Fiedorowicz Humbled by Hall Selection


The first thought Donna Fiedorowicz '80 had when informed she'd been chosen for induction into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame was of her CCSU coach and mentor, Dr. Brenda Reilly. "My immediate reaction was a mental image of Coach Reilly. The honor was as much for her as it was for me and everything she did for me as a coach, mentor and role model."

Fiedorowicz did a lot for Central in return. She was an extraordinary player and a gifted student. Her name can still be found all over the Blue Devils record book. She is the school's sixth all-time leading scorer with 1,233 points. She's third in number of points scored in a single season and second all-time in scoring average (25.9 points per game as a senior). The former star is also second in field goal average and second in single-season rebounding average with 11.6. She scored 39 points twice.

She has been equally successful in her career. Associated with the Professional Golfers Association Tour for more than 20 years, she currently serves as a vice president of the PGA Champions Tour. Her responsibilities include sponsor renewal, scheduling and oversight of the growth and development of each tournament, both fiscally and operationally.

Several other Blue Devils were members of the New England Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2006: Gene Reilly '67 in the Division II player category; Jere Quinn '78, honored for his long and successful coaching tenure at St. Thomas More Prep School; Cromwell High School boys coach Jake Salafia '56; and Old Saybrook High School girls coach Bill Reagan '65.

"I was proud to see other CCSU athletes included in the evening's celebration. It is always a rewarding experience to share celebratory moments with fellow alumni," said Fiedorowicz, who was inducted in the Division I player category.

Green Scores 200th Victory

Men's head soccer coach Shaun Green recorded a milestone victory during this past season. The veteran coach earned his 200th career win when the Blue Devils topped Quinnipiac, 4-1. They finished with a 6-8-2 overall record.

Green has been on the CCSU sidelines for 22 seasons and has a 200-170-41 overall record. He was Northeast Conference Coach of the Year in 2003.

Green was also the head coach in 1995 when Steven Jarvis became the first player in school history to be named a Division I All-American. Eighteen of his players have gone on to professional careers while many others have represented their respective nations in World Cup qualifying and at the World University Games.

Coach Green lives in Southington with his wife, Laurie, and their sons, Kenneth, Shane and Adam.



Justise Hairston

Hairston All-America Selection a CCSU First

Senior running back Justise Hairston became CCSU's first Division I-AA All-American after setting the single-season school rushing record with 1,847 yards. The old mark (1,413 yards) was established by Stan House in 1997. Hairston was the Division I-AA national rushing leader, averaging 167.9 yards per game. In addition to being named to the American Football Coaches Association All-America team, Hairston earned a number of other major regional and national honors and was a finalist for the prestigious Walter Payton Award.

The former New Britain High School standout also set a new single-game CCSU rushing mark when he gained 332 yards vs. St. Francis of Pennsylvania before a large Homecoming Day crowd. He also tied Central's single-game school record for touchdowns with five. Corey Harge was the previous single-game record-holder with 331 yards.

Hairston transferred to CCSU from Rutgers.


