

Thesis Proposal

1st step: presenting an exploratory proposal to your thesis advisor for his/her approval.¹

- a) Thesis Proposal Title.
- b) Statement of purpose (5-10 lines)
- c) Establish 2 research questions (5-6 lines)
- d) Literary review: incorporate a summary of the main findings of a scholarly article on the subject (10-15 lines).
- e) Beginning bibliography (3 entries or more)
- f) Can you anticipate what will be your contribution to the selected topic?
Elaborate your answer (2-4 lines).

¹ Your program advisor is not the same as the thesis advisor. Present your pre-proposal thesis to a faculty with whom you feel comfortable and that has expertise in the selected subject.
