application procedure

- Rolling Admission. First Year deadlines: May 1st for Fall Semester and December 1st for Spring Semester.
- First Year applicants must submit an official high school transcript, a personal essay, one recommendation letter, SAT/ACT scores, class rank, and \$50 application fee.
- Transfer deadlines: June 1st for Fall Semester and December 1st for Spring Semester.
- Transfer applicants must submit official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended, and \$50 application fee.
