

The University

Founded in 1849, Central Connecticut State University is the oldest public institution of higher education in Connecticut. In the fall semester of 2005, the University enrolled 12,315 students in programs of study offered in four schools. Through its outreach, athletic, cultural and international activities, CCSU touches the lives of a great many other people in its primary area (New Britain and Greater Hartford) as well as those of citizens of a great many other states and nations.

From its original building on the corner of Chestnut and Main in New Britain, CCSU has grown to 39 buildings located on 294 acres in New Britain and Newington. Its programs are offered around the world. Of the 7,445 full-time undergraduate students, approximately 1,878 live in campus residence halls, the remainder commuting to the campus for classes or residing in nearby apartments.

The Students

The following tables show the numbers of students in various classifications. Except where indicated, the table entries are *headcounts* -- the actual number of students in each category. FTE stands for *Full-Time-Equivalent*; credit hours divided by 15 for undergraduates and 12 for graduate students. Further tabulations are available upon request.
