



New Britain PD College Police Academy



The College Police Academy is an externship program that allows students to learn about the police profession while embedded within a police agency. This experiential learning and professional development opportunity are offered to undergraduate students, with priority given to Criminology Majors. Students will be exposed to the department's organization and rank structure, operational logistics and strategies, the generalist and specialist duties of sworn and civilian personnel, the application of law and administrative procedure, and community engagement. The academy provides students with an early opportunity to explore the career track. Typical programming requires a 4-week commitment. Students will be required to travel to the host agency approximately twice each week for about a three-hour session.

Prerequisites

CRM230 (preferred) and a cumulative GPA that is greater than or equal to 2.0 (preferred). Please submit special circumstances and/or questions to the program coordinator. Programming may be subject to change based on scheduling needs.

Enrollment Period

Enrollment for the New Britain College Police Academy is rolling (or ongoing) you can apply at any time to be considered for a future academy. New Britain PD intends to offer this academy in the Fall, Spring, and Summer. Dates and times past the current announcement are TBD.
