Students who are interested in taking the CEN 402 Community Engagement Internship Seminar should complete this application. PLEASE NOTE that CEN 200/201 Introduction to Community and Civic Engagement is a prerequisite for the Internship Seminar.

FEATURES OF THE COURSE:

- Students complete 120 hours of supervised work experience in an approved community agency or institution.
- Internship sites are chosen in cooperation with the CEN 402 Instructor *before* the start of the semester.
- Students attend one-hour seminar meetings with the CEN 402 instructor throughout the semester.
- Academic assignments will be completed per the course syllabus.
