Upon receipt of your written and video materials, we will evaluate the materials within two weeks and send the results to central admissions. Central admissions will send a letter of results for both admission to CCSU and to the music program.

Students who have been accepted and have confirmed attending CCSU will be contacted from the Department of Music over the summer about an optional Music Theory Exam to test out of MUS 102: Fundamentals of Musicianship. Transfer students will want to set up an initial advising session to talk about how courses will transfer.
