



## What to Bring / What Not to Bring

This is a list of items residents typically bring each year, and a list of prohibited items. Please note that the items to bring is not all inclusive and no item on the list is required. Particularly this semester due to COVID19, we encourage students to pack light and bring only essential items. We recommend retaining boxes, suitcases and bags, should you need to pack up quickly due to a campus closing.

PERMITTED ITEMS	PROHIBITED/RESTRICTED ITEMS
<p><b>Aquariums</b> (for flake-eating fish only) –tank not to exceed 10 gallons. One per room.</p> <p><b>Bicycles</b> – must not block egress (door or window of room).</p> <p><b>Black lights</b> – must not be used to replace fixtures provided by university.</p> <p><b>Furniture/Couches/sofas/chairs</b> – Collapsible folding chairs only.</p> <p><b>Electronic cigarettes</b> – Must be used outside of the residence halls in designated smoking areas.</p> <p><b>Fitness weights</b> – not to exceed 10 pounds.</p> <p><b>Hair dryers/straighteners</b> – hand held only, must be U.L. approved. To be used in bathrooms and bedrooms only.</p> <p><b>Indoor/outdoor decorative lights</b> – must be UL approved. Can't be hung near sprinkler heads or ceilings.</p> <p><b>Irons</b> – must have auto shut-off, to be used on desktop boards.</p> <p><b>Ironing boards</b> – only desktop boards allowed.</p> <p><b>Kuerig</b> - For use in kitchen only</p> <p><b>Lamps</b> – desk top lamps, no floor lamps</p> <p><b>Microwave/Refrigerator – Standard room:</b> 1 refrigerator (maximum 5.0 cubic feet, Energy Star rated) and 1 microwave (not to exceed 700w) is permitted. <b>Suite:</b> 1 microwave is permitted, per suite (not to exceed 700w). One refrigerator per room within the suite is permitted. Note: If using a microwave/ refrigerator combination unit, must be one-plug technology. Click this link for more information about rentals: <a href="http://www.netstudentservices.com/">http://www.netstudentservices.com/</a></p> <p><b>Musical instruments</b> – subject to quiet hours and 24-hour courtesy hours.</p> <p><b>Plug strip/surge protector</b> – must have built-in circuit breaker &amp; UL approved.</p> <p><b>Radios/stereos</b> – only one per room due to the power allotment for each room.</p> <p><b>Refrigerators</b> – the unit must be UL approved and draw a maximum two amps due to power allotment in the rooms. <u>Only one per room.</u></p> <p><b>Television</b> – due to the power allotment for each room, only one per room. Students encouraged to bring TVs no larger than 40”</p> <p><b>Vacuums</b> – handhelds only (no uprights or canisters).</p> <p><b>Posters/wall coverings</b> – must not exceed 50% of wall space.</p> <p><b>Wastebaskets</b> – must be made of metal or plastic (no wicker wastebaskets permitted)</p> <p><b>Cleaning Supplies</b> - Students are encouraged to bring their own cleaning supplies for their rooms and to clean their space regularly.</p> <p><b>Personal Mask/Face Covering</b> - Students are encouraged to bring their own personal mask(s). If unable to do so, students should speak with staff.</p>	<p><b>Air conditioners</b></p> <p><b>Alcohol beverages/containers (empty or filled)</b></p> <p><b>Alcohol paraphernalia</b></p> <p><b>Amplifiers</b></p> <p><b>B-B guns</b></p> <p><b>Candles (with or without wicks) or Oil/wax tart warmers</b></p> <p><b>Cardboard drawer units</b></p> <p><b>Ceiling fans</b></p> <p><b>Coffee pots or coffee makers used in rooms/suites</b></p> <p><b>Dart boards with point tip darts</b></p> <p><b>Drug paraphernalia, such as bong</b></p> <p><b>Duct tape</b></p> <p><b>Electric appliances</b></p> <p><b>Extension cords (only surge protectors permitted)</b></p> <p><b>Furniture (No furniture except folding chairs; i.e. no futons, couches, or non-collapsible chairs)</b></p> <p><b>Firearms, including air rifles</b></p> <p><b>Fireworks</b></p> <p><b>Fishnets and other ceiling decorations</b></p> <p><b>Fitness equipment</b></p> <p><b>Flammable liquids</b></p> <p><b>Full-size sofas/couches</b></p> <p><b>Gasoline</b></p> <p><b>Gasoline-powered equipment</b></p> <p><b>Halogen bulb fixtures</b></p> <p><b>Heating elements</b></p> <p><b>Hot plates or hot pots</b></p> <p><b>Hover boards</b></p> <p><b>Hookah</b></p> <p><b>Incense</b></p> <p><b>Knives (other than kitchen knives)</b></p> <p><b>Lamps (plastic fixtures, kerosene, oil types, lava lamps)</b></p> <p><b>Loft units</b></p> <p><b>Multi-outlet adapters</b></p> <p><b>Noise makers such as bull horns, vuvuzela or megaphones</b></p> <p><b>Non-university mattress</b></p> <p><b>Paint/paint thinner</b></p> <p><b>Pets (except fish)</b></p> <p><b>Portable heaters</b></p> <p><b>Sun lamps</b></p> <p><b>Sub/woofers</b></p> <p><b>Toasters of any kind</b></p> <p><b>Vaporizers or humidifier</b></p> <p><b>Weapons of any kind</b></p> <p><b>Wicker furniture or wastepaper baskets</b></p> <p><b>Wireless router</b></p>
