FAQ

When are applications due, and when will decision notifications go out?

Applications are due on Friday, March 29th, by 5:00 PM. Decision notifications will go out mid-April.

When will the stipend be awarded?

The stipend will be split into three equal payments. One payment will be issued at the end of the Summer, one at the end of the Fall semester, and the last issued at the end of the Spring semester.

Who is eligible to apply?

This cohort experience is open to all full-time CCSU faculty across all academic fields of study. We strongly encourage applications from junior faculty.

What kind of resources will be given to support the cohort?

Resources will include a faculty handbook, scholarly literature, guest speakers, coffee hours with CCESR staff, and more.
