Subj: UPBC FY 26 Funding Recommendations for 1) Base Budgets Requests, 2) One-time

Requests, and 3) Capital Equipment Requests

The University Planning and Budget Committee (UPBC) thanks all Executive Committee members for their budget submissions and responses to questions from the UPBC. The total amounts requested for each of the three funding categories (Base Budget Increases, One-time Requests, and Capital Equipment Requests) exceeded the amounts the UPBC was told would likely be available for FY26. In order to fairly assess the needs of the various divisions, the UPBC agreed to support all the requests that were flagged as "must haves" by the division heads. This resulted in the UBC supporting \$375,000 out of a possible \$500,000 for base budget increases, \$114,323 out of a possible \$500,000 for one-time funding, and \$1,399,500 out of a possible \$1,000,000 for capital equipment (Table 1). If the Base Budget and One-time requests categorized as "highest" (Table 2) or "high" (Table 3) by the respective Division Heads were also recommended by the UPBC, the requests would far exceed what would be available. The UPBC also notes that Academic Affairs did not rank any requests as "must-haves" or "highest" and so the UPBC chose to look more closely at the funding requests from this division. Tables 4, 5, and 6 show the UPBC recommendations for funding for Academic Affairs requests. Lastly, Table 7 shows the final recommendation totals from the UPBC for FY26 by source and division.
