## **EXCLUSIONS:**

\*Hybrid Courses: On-ground final exam times are NOT automatically scheduled for Hybrid courses (Banner Schedule Type = HY).

Students enrolled in a Hybrid course: Consult with your professor if an on-ground exam will be held.

\*Courses of 1 Credit (or less): Exams are to be held on the last day of class before the start of final exam week.

\*Final exams will be held in their regularly scheduled classrooms unless notified by the professor.

\*The final exam schedule is created from the standard course meeting time blocks. If your course does not follow a standard meeting time (including hybrid courses and couses meeting alternating weeks), please consult with the Registrar's Office to identify the final exam block that most closely aligns with your course meeting time.
