- Media Center: working with campus departments to enhance space (journalism, etc)/design plans for refresh to align with current technology

Davidson Hall

- Academic Affairs suite construction has commenced, target completion Summer 2024
- Relocation of MARCOM from Maria Sanford and Davidson to former Admissions space
- Relocation of Community Engagement to first floor

Copernicus Hall

- Lab improvements are ongoing (137, 324 recently completed). Follow up meeting with Provost to determine next set of rooms/priority
 - Support letters are being sent to Appropriations Committee in support of the forensics lab on campus
 - Creates opportunities for other disciplines (Chemistry, etc)
 - o Interdisciplinary Forensic Science major'
- Process for new projects/requests will be issued in the future

Memorial Hall

- Overview of existing building (temporary air conditioning, roof replacement needed, ventilation and ductwork needed)
- DCS project slated for completion in late 2026, intent is to never fully shut down the building

AIH

• Sound reduction work ongoing

Maria Sanford

- Analyzing costs and challenges of the vacated MARCOM space for Cybersecurity
- Currently an accelerated Masters in Cybersecurity is being added
- This project allows for continued community partnerships (Co-ops, Governor's Workforce Council)
- Strong demand for traditional programs and cyber manufacturing interdisciplinary programs

Vance Academic Center

- AI initiative creation of new environments
 - Purpose built research for students and faculty (room 010)-AI Technology
 - o Teaching/learning space in general (cobots, augmentation)
 - AI minor in progress/develop CS degree with concentration in AI

Asian American/Asian Pacific Islander Center

- Other centers have physical space on campus, plan to use former Caribbean Center space in Library'
- Further clarification on space needs to be confirmed with the Provost
