Student Learning & Licensure (SL&L) Guide:

Students enrolled in an Educator Preparation Program (EPP) within the School of Education are required to purchase a membership to the SL&L platform.

What Is Student Learning & Licensure (SL&L)?

SL&L is an online platform that all teacher candidates **must** use throughout their professional program. It serves as a centralized hub for:

- Completing assignments and organizing artifacts
- Logging field experience hours
- Creating an online portfolio to showcase learning and share with employers
- Allowing instructors to evaluate student-learning outcomes based on established standards

How & When to Purchase Your SL&L Account:

Students must purchase their SL&L account upon acceptance into the Professional Program and no later than the last day of the add/drop period of their first semester in professional education coursework.

Steps to Purchase & Access Your SL&L Account:

- 1. **Go to:** <u>sll.watermarkinsights.com</u>
- 2. First-time users: Click "Forgot Password" and enter your CCSU email address.
- 3. **Reset your password:** Follow the instructions in the "Reset Password" email sent to your CCSU account.
- 4. Purchase your subscription:
 - One-time fee: \$147.83
- 5. Sign in: Return to the SL&L login page, enter your CCSU email and new password, then click "SIGN IN."
