ATI TEAS TEST: INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

The ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is a multiple-choice test that evaluates student competencies needed for the Nursing Program curriculum.

As of June 2022 - ATI has transitioned to Version 7 of the exam. Results of other exam types (i.e. HESI, etc.) and previous versions of the TEAS will NOT be accepted.

What does the TEAS test consist of?

The ATI TEAS exam is comprised of a 170, multiple choice-fill-in-the blank questions. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills perform in class in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science and English and Language usage.

The TEAS Test is created and managed by ATI.

TEAS test location, duration and cost:

- Test may be taken Online remote proctored exam - managed by ATI or in person proctored at a PSI testing center - see details on ATI TEAS webpage.
- The duration of the exam is 209 minutes or 3.48 hours
- There is a cost for this test charged by ATI and is not linked to any CCSU Account.

When to take the TEAS test?

- The CCSU Nursing Department allows students to take the TEAS a **maximum of 3 times in calendar year**, with a 1-month window in between test dates.
- Typically, students will take the TEAS in **November, December, January**
- If a minimum score of 70% is not achieved – student **MUST WAIT** one month between testing again.
- Deadline for LAST considered score on ATI exam is February 1st of the year student submits application. (i.e., student submits application 2/15/2025 - last eligible score must be before 2/1/2025)

Is the TEAS required?



Yes, the adjusted individualized total score will count as 25% of the total admission application to the nursing major. **Applicants must obtain a minimum, adjusted score of 70%.** This score reflects the national mean of BSN programs nationwide.

Preparation:

Information about the test format, study guide, and online practice assessments, as well as how to prepare for the test is available on the website, atitesting.com.

How to Create an account with ATI for TEAS Exam

Go to **atitesting.com**, when prompted to select a site, click on “I AM PREPPARING FOR OR TAKING THE TEAS”



At the top right corner “**CREATE ACCOUNT**”

STEP 1 - Create a Username and Password, enter an email address. Click Continue. **We recommend using a username, password, and email that is easy to remember.**

STEP 2 – Complete the 3 Security Questions. Click Continue.

STEP 3 – Enter your Personal Information. Click Continue.

STEP 4 – Here you will pick your testing Institution. Select “**Central CT State U**” Enter your Student ID if you have one and click non-degree seeking, click Continue

STEP 5 – Complete the Demographic Information, only required field is Date of Birth. Click Continue.

STEP 6 – Subscription, Updates & Notes – Select the checkbox if you would like to receive communication, students do not have to select yes to continue. Click Continue.

STEP 7 – Read the User Terms and Conditions, select the checkbox, students must select “Yes” to complete registration. Click Register.
