Program Overview:

- Option to start the program in either late spring (May/June) or fall (September) or winter (January)
- 30 credit program (12 courses) completed in 2 years
- Accelerated option may be available for those already holding a degree beyond a masters' and pursuing only the 092 endorsement
- Flexibility to provide a tailored experiences with courses offered in diverse delivery formats, including hybrid and online options
- Administrative internship (typically in your own school/district) under the supervision of a local mentor and university supervisor
- Offers an option for a concentration of courses in special education leadership
- Possible cohort model, with a majority of our program offered at specified district or regional location (designed to fit group needs)
- Option for federal financial aid with 6-credit hours per semester
- Recent graduates have gone on to take positions as: *principals, asst.principals, instructional coaches, department chairs, directors of curriculum and instruction, directors of special education, directors of DEI, professional learning coordinators, higher education professors and adjuncts, to name a few.*
