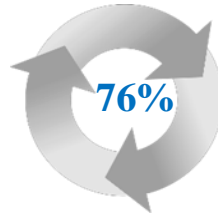

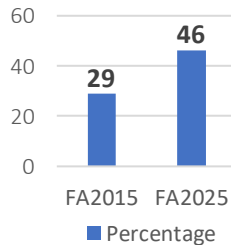

Number of Students by Race/Ethnicity

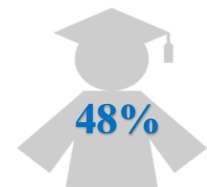
