Courses are taught on campus and appointments by semester.

EXS 211 Anatomy & Physiology 1 Lab: Explores hands-on examination of the skeletal system, integumentary and bone history, anatomical planes of movement, and the articular and muscle origin and insertions

EXS 212 Anatomy & Physiology 2 Lab: Explores measurement of physiological variables in the nervous, respiratory, cardiovascular, and skeletal muscle systems

Required Qualifications:

- Master's degree or higher in the related field as specified above
- Professional experience that is current, substantial in terms of duration and level of responsibility
- Commitment to serving culturally, ethnically and linguistically diverse communities.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree in the related field as specified above
- Professional Certification the related field as specified above
- Strong teaching skills, and have an ability to use technology effectively in teaching and learning
- Evidence of quality teaching experience

Candidates must demonstrate appropriate mastery of the subject area; provide students with appropriate learning materials; evaluate students' performance and provide effective feedback to guide student learning and success; keep samples of students' work for accreditation purposes; and contribute to maintaining an inclusive and collaborative environment.
