Central Connecticut State University’s Spanish Certificate for Health Professionals is a **15-CREDIT PROGRAM**. Central Nursing and Social Work students, as well as those interested in careers in healthcare, will develop improved comprehension and fluency in Spanish. The goal is to improve the healthcare experience and outcomes for Spanish speakers.

Students who enroll in the first cohort—**up to 30 students**—and complete the certificate during Spring semester will have the opportunity to take a spring break trip to a Spanish speaking country, where they will participate in immersive cultural and healthcare experiences.

Students will acquire Spanish language skills at the intermediate level in the context of healthcare scenarios

SPAN 130: Intermediate Spanish for Health Professionals II	3 Credits
Students will expand their Spanish language skills at the intermediate level in the context of healthcare scenarios	
Pre-Req: SPAN 129 or Instructor Permission	
SPAN 229: Advanced Intermediate Spanish for Health Professionals	3 Credits
Students will become familiar with cultural norms of the Hispanic population and their importance in the care of Latino patients while refining their Spanish language skills at the intermediate-high level	
Pre-Req: SPAN 130 or Instructor Permission	
SPAN 404: Medical Translation	3 Credits
Students will refine their linguistic skills and will expand their knowledge of medical terminology and apply them in the translation of major text types in the field of healthcare	
Pre-Req: SPAN 229 or Instructor Permission	
SPAN 441: Cross Cultural Communication	3 Credits
Students will become familiar with cultural constraints in communication and apply that knowledge in culturally appropriate translations and interactions with Spanish speakers
