

SENTENCE 1:

Author name, credentials, genre, and title of work, date in parenthesis; a rhetorically active verb, and a THAT clause containing a message or theme explored by the text.

SENTENCE 2:

A brief 1-2 sentence **summary** that includes a reference to the **main argument, data, and research methods.**

SENTENCE 3:

An explanation of how the author **organizes their research** to develop and convey the **argument.**

WRITING A BOOK REVIEW

SENTENCE 4:

A statement of the author's apparent purpose, followed by an "in order to" which explains what the author wants the intended audience to *feel, think* and/or *do*

SENTENCE 5:

A description of a place in the text in which the author uses a literary device to achieve a specific purpose.

SENTENCE 6:

A description of a primary and secondary audience with a description of the evidence you used to identify the audience.
