Change the Script is a statewide campaign, funded by the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, to rewrite the narrative around prescription drug misuse and prevent overdoses in Connecticut.

The campaign features community resource vans that meet people where they live and work to provide medication safety, harm reduction, and educational materials. The Change the Script Resource Van provides:

- Medication lock boxes and Deterra pouches to support the **safe storage and disposal of medications**
- **Harm reduction materials** such as Naloxone and test strips for Fentanyl and Xylazine
- **Educational materials** on substance use and mental health disorders, prevention, health promotion and wellness, treatment and recovery, and other related topics
