### Paid Student Positions Available:

We are seeking **five student workers** to conduct an interdisciplinary feasibility study for a community-based digital equity program. This project offers the opportunity to gain practical experience, apply IT and management skills to a real-world initiative, contribute meaningfully to the community, enhance experiential learning portfolio, and potentially build connections with local organizations and industry partners.

### Preferred Skills/Background:

- **Technical:** Computer hardware, networking, cybersecurity, basic electronics
- **Analytical & Business:** Process design, project management, communications

### Potential Tasks Include (subject to revision):

- Analyzing the feasibility of a device donation pipeline from businesses to local high schools
- Designing workflows, intake processes, and needed toolkits/workbooks
- Identifying required resources, potential partners, and future CCSU students' involvements as necessary (new club, workshops for community, development and management of an inventory/distribution system, etc.)
- Preparing a report and presentation for internal/external stakeholders

- Payment: **\$20/hour**, up to 15 hours/week
- Project timeline: starting **early March** for 8 weeks
- Faculty-supervised applied learning experience
