Part-Time Faculty Load Credits includes load credit given to Lecturers for instructional activity (as defined above), and excludes all part-time coaches, librarians, counselors and non-teaching lecturers (include any load credits given to non-teaching lecturers attributable to instructional activities pursuant to 10.2.1, 10.4.1 & 10.4.2 of the CSU-AAUP Contract).

Number of Instr. Load Credits from UG Level: The Load Credits are determined by the course numbering (course numbers that are under 500 belong to the undergraduate level).

Number of Instr. Load Credits from GR Level: The Load Credits are determined by the course numbering (course numbers that are 500 and above belong to the graduate level).
