- Substance Use

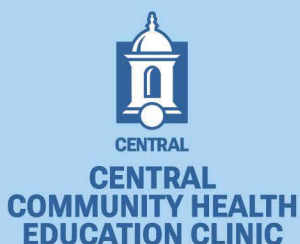
\* **DISCLAIMER:**
