The Provost has been asked to provide the committee with some concepts of what kind of technology they might need to support the programs. This information, along with the information we have collected, will allow us to see if we have the space and resources to accommodate these items. If equipment might consist of large items such as equipment for manufacturing, etc. this would require much larger spaces which would need to be considered. We would need to assess whether we already have space that could be utilized or if new spaces would be needed.

Also, the staff needed to support the programs will need office spaces, research spaces may be needed, along with additional classroom spaces and labs. Our data on the physical and technological infrastructure will be useful in determining if we have the space to properly support the programs or if additional space would be needed. As programs grow, the number of staff must grow as well, and we would need to make sure we have the space needed to support that growth systematically on both sides.
