Preferred Qualifications:

- A Ph.D. in an appropriate field
- Coursework in or experience with writing assessment, use of technology, writing or learning center work, literary theory, and/or working with diverse student populations.

We are looking for individuals who are passionate about teaching and mentoring students and who can contribute effectively to our academic programs.

Responsibilities include:

- Teaching undergraduate general education courses (especially first-year writing)
- Preparing course materials, lectures, and assignments
- Collecting assessment data
- Supporting student learning and engagement
