How Students Can Schedule Their Move-in Appointment

- Go to the Student Central Pipeline page and log into WebCentral-Banner Web
- Click on MyHousing and go to your housing assignment
- Under your assignment, use the drop-down menu to select your time block
- Click **Update My Time** to save your selection

What Students Should do Before Move-In Day

- Submit health forms and meningitis vaccine records via the Medcat Portal by August 9
- Review the packing list and coordinate with your roommate
- Request a Parking Decal, if needed
- Print Parking Permit Card and bring it with you (printed copies will also be available on-site)
- Bring your photo ID or Central ID





WHAT STUDENTS CAN EXPECT ON MOVE-IN DAY

- Arrive at your confirmed time – you'll have a 30-minute window
- Bring your green wristband (issued only after health clearance)
- Friends/family may assist with move-in
- Movers will assist students; bins will be available in lobbies
- Use stairs when possible to minimize elevator wait times
- Break down and discard boxes in designated dumpsters
