James was also kind enough to agree to send the notes to our committee as well. Though the forum was about problems at CCSU in general, Jessica reported many concerns about advising:

- Advisor's refusing to help
- Advisor mistakes with course selection and sequencing
- Advisor's not knowing answers to questions
- Lack of support for non-traditional students
- Mary Pat wondered if the system would be better if there was a chance for a faculty response to the concerns so the students know they were being heard
 - Yvonne noted her idea to summarize the results, bring up key issues and create a panel to suggest solutions.
 - Mary Pat noted that our committee might be a big part of the panel
 - Jason wondered whether our survey results will coincide with the select group of motivated students that attended the forum

- Some wondered when we should try to set up some sort of forum
 - Things are fresh now with all of the controversy in the Senate
 - Mary Pat wondered if we should note our desire to have an open forum to SGA. We could highlight that we are a diverse group from all over campus who want to help create change
 - Kevin wondered whether it would be better next semester when we have all the survey results and can maybe even provide some data driven coaching to students about how to be the best advisee they can. As mentioned by Mary, we need students to want to take responsibility for their own advising too
