

David G. Carter

Carter Named CSU Chancellor

David G. Carter, president of Eastern Connecticut State University (ECSU) for the past 17 years, has been named chancellor of the Connecticut State University system. Carter takes over from Dr. William J. Cibes, Jr., who retired Feb. 1, 2006 after serving eleven years as chancellor.

Chosen after an exhaustive nationwide search, assisted by a national search firm and committees composed of trustees, faculty, staff and students, Carter becomes the fourth chancellor of Connecticut's largest public university system.

"David is an individual of great integrity, as well as an outstanding scholar and administrator," said Lawrence D. McHugh, chair of the CSU Board of Trustees. "We believe his years of experience and commitment to higher education will greatly benefit CSU, and we believe the new energy and perspective he will bring to the position will help the four CSU universities secure their positions among the best public universities in the nation."

Prior to his move to ECSU, Carter was a professor and member of the graduate faculty in the Department of Educational Administration at the University of Connecticut, and a professor at Pennsylvania State University.

Carter earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education at Central State University in Ohio. He received the M.Ed. in curriculum and supervision at Miami (Ohio) University and the Ph.D. in educational development and educational administration from Ohio State University.

Carmen Espinosa '71

Carmen Espinosa has forged an amazing career path. Her professional journey, which began with teaching, has included law school, an appointment as a special agent with the FBI, and several high-level posts in the legal and judicial systems.

The first Hispanic woman appointed to the bench in Connecticut, Espinosa currently serves as a Superior Court judge in Hartford, where she presides over the most serious felony cases, including murder, sexual assault, and other criminal offenses. But long before she held a gavel, Espinosa was positioned for success.

Born in Puerto Rico, Espinosa moved to Connecticut with her family when she was three years old. "My family moved here in 1951, and we were one of the first Puerto Rican families in New Britain," she recalls. "My father worked as a laborer and my mother worked in a factory." The youngest of three children, Espinosa and her siblings attended public schools. "My parents valued education and instilled in us a strong work ethic. We lived on Franklin Square, which is interesting, because years later when I was assigned to New Britain as a judge, I could see the area where our house used to stand from the window of my chambers."

Espinosa majored in French and Spanish while working on her teaching degree at Central. Graduating with honors, she was awarded a fellowship to Brown University, where she earned her master's degree.

"A lot of the things that happened to me were fortuitous. I was at the right place at the right time," says Espinosa. "For instance, I was the first child in my family to graduate from college. As the youngest, I reaped the benefits of my older siblings' experience. Once I got into college, I liked to learn and had good professors. And, of course, I got the fellowship to Brown."

After finishing her master's program, Espinosa returned to Connecticut and a teaching position in Southington. But she soon discovered that, although she enjoyed working with students, she didn't care for the routine and repetition of language instruction. A chance encounter with a former classmate planted the seed for her next important career move. "I was in New Britain after returning from Brown, and I ran into a fellow I knew from Central. He told me that he was going to law school, and that's really what started me thinking about it."

Talent and Timing Lead to Judge's Success

Espinosa attended the George Washington University Law School, just a few subway stops away from the most powerful government agencies in the nation, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

"The FBI thing was kind of unexpected, too," she says. "I was getting ready to graduate, and the placement office had a series of folders where you could file your resume, so I printed up a bunch of resumes and put them in the folders. I didn't even know one of them was for the FBI. Then one day a recruiter called me and said, 'This is so-and-so from the FBI, and we're interested in you.' And it took off from there."

"Being an FBI agent was very difficult," Espinosa continues. "I think I was the 68th woman ever hired by the FBI. They used to assign you a number because the agency was just starting to open up to women after [FBI Director J. Edgar] Hoover died and Clarence Kelley came in."

In 1980, Espinosa came back to Connecticut and was hired as an assistant U.S. attorney by Richard Blumenthal, the U.S. Attorney for Connecticut at the time. "I thought that was the best job in the world, which it was," she recalls. Espinosa remained in the job for twelve years, until she was appointed to the bench in 1992.



“I consider Central to be the linchpin of my professional career. It was at Central that I learned that I could succeed at whatever academic pursuit I undertook. My preparation at Central placed me on par with students at an Ivy League school and at a national law school. That is testament to the quality of the education I received at Central.” — Carmen Espinosa

It was then, when Lowell Weicker became governor, that Espinosa's full potential was recognized and realized. “Governor Weicker's chief of staff was Stanley Twardy, who was my boss, the U.S. Attorney at the time. Then Judge Michael Hartmere was appointed, which got us all thinking. Once again, another great opportunity arose, and I was there.”

Being selected for the bench was a great honor, recounts Espinosa. “My appointment had a big impact on the Hispanic community, because one of its members was elevated to a high position. Personally, having progressed through the ranks, it was the culmination of my legal career. It was a big achievement for me and a source of pride for my family.”

What she enjoys most about her job, Espinosa says, is “the intellectual challenge and the interaction with people of all walks of life.” Conversely, the toughest part is sentencing defendants after conviction. “Sentencing is the most difficult part of the job, because the decision affects a lot of people's lives—not just the defendant's, but the victim's and the victim's family. You have to balance all of the considerations and factors that go into a sentence, and it's not an easy thing.”

Despite such demands, Espinosa is happy with her career. Though not quick to admit it, she has worked hard to get where she is today. She has made the most of the opportunities that have come her way. And she has benefited from good timing, as well. “I was fortunate to come up at a time when opportunities were opening up for women and for minorities,” she says. “The fact that I was a woman and a Puerto Rican, I'm sure, helped me in my career path. Really, when you think about it, I haven't had many jobs in my life. I was a teacher, an FBI agent, a prosecutor, and a judge...four jobs in my adult life. I'm very, very lucky.” □



Francis M. "Bud" Mullen '62

Countless CCSU graduates pursue careers in law enforcement and the legal system. Each one is helping to make our communities safe. Here is what a few alumni are doing:

Now fully retired, **Francis M. “Bud” Mullen** had a lifelong career in law enforcement, first with the FBI and then with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA). Mullen,

who attended CCSU during the day while working as a New London police officer at night, joined the FBI shortly after finishing his undergraduate degree. Over the next two decades, he worked his way up the ranks at the bureau's offices in Los Angeles, Denver, Tampa, and New Orleans.

“My original plan was to teach, but I really enjoyed the law enforcement work I was doing in New London,” Mullen recalls. “When I finished college, I applied for the Connecticut State Police and for the FBI, and I also signed a teaching contract in Waterford, CT. But when the FBI came through, I accepted that appointment, and I always felt I made the right choice.”

Among other positions at the FBI, Mullen served as inspector and deputy assistant director, Organized Crime and White Collar Crime; assistant director, Criminal Investigation Division, and executive assistant director, Investigations. In 1981, he was appointed DEA administrator by President Ronald Reagan, serving in an acting capacity until his Senate confirmation in 1983. After leaving the DEA, Mullen returned to Connecticut as director of the Mohegan Tribal Gaming Commission in Uncasville.

Mullen was married with two children when he enrolled at CCSU. Having already served in the military, he used the G.I. bill to go to college. “I was serious about my education,” he says. “I felt I had outstanding professors at CCSU, and I learned a lot from them.”

Mullen has passed on his love of law enforcement. Several of his children have jobs in related fields, and his granddaughter currently is pursuing a degree in criminal justice at CCSU. Though retired, Mullen remains active in an association of former narcotic agents as well as a society of former FBI agents. “I'm not as knowledgeable as I once was,” he admits, “but I am still interested.” ▶





Lori (Arnone) Coppinger '80

Lori Coppinger is detective captain with the West Hartford Police Department, a position she has held for two years. A member of the WHPD for more than 21 years, Coppinger previously spent one year as captain of support services, in which capacity she was in charge of training and the traffic division. She also supervised the department's two K-9 teams for about ten years.

"I got to where I am today through hard work and dedication," says Coppinger. "As one of only two female officers of rank in a department of 128 officers, I started at a time when women were not welcome in the job, so I had the unwanted burden of proving that women were capable of handling this profession."

While at CCSU, Coppinger majored in sociology and worked as a student helper in the Campus Police Department. She also acquired martial arts training by joining the Karate Club. "I earned my black belt," recalls Coppinger, "which helped me to develop confidence and the physical ability to handle difficult situations."

Coppinger notes that CCSU prepared her to continue her academic pursuits beyond the undergraduate level. She went on to obtain her master's in theology from Holy Apostle College and Seminary, and she currently serves as chaplain for the Connecticut Association of Women Police. Over the years, Coppinger has taken training classes in many aspects of police work, including an eleven-week training course in leadership at the FBI Academy in Quantico, VA. When not working, she teaches a class in Police Organization and Administration at Northwestern Community College.



Robert F. Mullins '94

Robert Mullins literally grew up in Kaiser Hall. From the ages of about 6 to 12, he was the ball boy for the CCSU basketball team, and he attended Central's day camp during the summer. "The coaches in Physical Education really looked out for me," says Mullins, "so when it came time to go to college, I had to choose Central."

Currently, Mullins is an attorney with the law firm of O'Donnell and Riley in New Haven. The firm, which he joined about ten months ago, practices criminal and civil litigation. Previously, Mullins spent twenty years in the New Haven Police Department, the last seven of which he worked as a detective in burglary/robbery, child physical abuse, sexual abuse, and auto theft.

Mullins earned his B.A. in communication with a minor in public administration. He took classes during the day while working the late shift at the police department. "My professors at Central knew that I worked full-time and attended classes," says Mullins. He remembers two professors in particular, Dr. Cindy White (Communication) and Dr. Ghassan El-Eid (Political Science), who recommended classes that helped him to achieve his goals.

"Dr. White knew I was considering a career beyond police work, and she encouraged me to continue my education beyond the undergraduate level," says Mullins. "It was, in large part, due to her motivation that I earned my master's in criminal justice and a certificate of graduate study at the University of New Haven. Following that, I went to law school."

"It was my experience growing up at Central, first through athletics with great coaches like Bill Detrick, Hank Majlinger, and Julian "Jigger" Wojtusik, and later with the great professors I had, that allowed me to achieve success in my professional life," he concludes. ☐

Ed.D. Program *In A Class* By Itself

Last December, sixteen candidates for the Ed.D. in educational leadership received their diplomas in a special commencement ceremony on campus. The ceremony was significant for several reasons: it was the first time the University graduated doctoral students; it marked the 50th anniversary of graduate studies at CCSU; and it featured the investiture of Central's new president, Dr. John W. Miller.

"It was exciting to mark three such important events simultaneously," exclaims Dr. Karen Beyard, a professor of educational leadership and director of the Ed.D. program. "To have the first doctoral students walk the stage and receive their hoods was a stunning moment for the University."

Bringing the Ed.D. to life took years of hard work by many people. According to Beyard, talk of such a program began in the mid-70s. But it wasn't until 1991, when Dr. Richard Arends was hired as dean of the School of Education, that things started to take shape. "Dick really began to plan and argue for it," says Beyard. The program finally received approval from the Connecticut Department of Higher Education in 2001, and the first cohort of students arrived on campus the following summer.

With so much time and energy invested, has the program worked out as planned?

"Well, we expected that some students would start but not finish," says Beyard. "But almost four years into the program, not a single student has quit." As a result, the program has moved from annual admissions to alternate-year admissions.

"We simply ended up with more people in the program at any one time than we had anticipated," Beyard says.

Beyond that, the program was designed to have a strong connection both to the field and to practice. "We hoped that our graduates would be able to aspire to more influential leadership positions as a result of their studies, and that they would be able to use research to improve education in Connecticut. Both of these are beginning to happen," Beyard observes.

Other interesting developments have occurred along the way. For one, as the program's reputation has spread, it has attracted clusters of students from individual districts. "When that happens," explains Beyard, "there is a real opportunity to impact practice in the district, because we know what they need, they understand what we can do, and we begin to work in partnership."

The program currently enrolls students from school districts surrounding the University—including New Britain, Hartford, West Hartford, Bloomfield, and Newington—as well as from such far-reaching locales as Westchester County. "People have been willing not only to give up the necessary time to pursue full-time study, but also to commute a significant distance to be a part of our program," notes Beyard.

Another distinctive aspect of the program is the post-dissertation requirement: Each student must present a conference paper or submit a manuscript for publication in a journal. "Our students aren't allowed to put their dissertation on the shelf, heave a big sigh of relief, and go back to business as usual," says Beyard. "They are obliged to figure out a way to bring their findings both to the world of practice and to the scholarly world—and, hopefully, to continue to think that way." ☐

Hyundai Motor America Presents \$3 Million Gift to CCSU

Hyundai Motor America, the U.S. subsidiary of Hyundai Motor Company of Korea, has presented CCSU with a gift of \$3 million, the largest single endowment in the University's 156-year history.

The funds will be used to establish the Dr. Mong Koo Chung/Hyundai Motor America Endowment Fund, named in honor of Hyundai Motor Company's chairman, to enable Korean and CCSU students and faculty to study and lecture at CCSU and in the Republic of Korea.

In announcing the gift, Jeon Kap Lee, president of Hyundai Motor Company, said, "CCSU has been a long and steady partner with Hyundai. The University has always recognized the importance of forming and strengthening Korean-American relationships for the purpose of improving educational opportunities, business exchanges and international sharing." He went on to note that, "From 1995 to 1997, many Hyundai business leaders and executives, including myself, had an opportunity to participate in the Global Leadership Program on the CCSU campus. As I take pride in being one of the first graduates of that program, it gives me great pleasure to present the scholarship fund endowment on behalf of Chairman Chung."

The relationship between CCSU and Hyundai dates back to the 1980s. In 1989, the University acknowledged Chairman Chung's global leadership by awarding him an honorary degree.

Hyundai Motor America, headquartered in Fountain Valley, CA, sells and distributes cars and sports utility vehicles through 640 dealerships across the United States. Hyundai sold its first car in the U.S. in 1986, and has since grown into the fourth best-selling foreign manufacturer in the nation.

Both Sweeney and Ziegler went on to earn master's degrees from the Newhouse School of Communications at Syracuse University.

The panel discussion was the first presentation at a larger conference, entitled *The Speed of Light: Pictures, Print, News and Sports*. Among the featured speakers was John A. Walsh, executive vice president and executive editor of ESPN, Inc., and a former managing editor of *Rolling Stone* magazine and *U.S. News & World Report*, who reflected on the diverse, high-level nature of his career as it relates to broader issues in journalism, communication, sports and society. *Hartford Courant* Photo Editor John Long, a nationally recognized specialist in photography and ethics, also spoke and gave a visual presentation on "Journalism Ethics in the Age of Digital Photography."

Dr. Karen Ritzenhoff, associate professor of communication, served as moderator for the conference, which was organized by Drs. Tony Cannella and Vivian Martin, associate professors of English, and sponsored by the Robert C. Vance Foundation, the CCSU Communication Department, the Journalism Program of the English Department and the School of Arts and Sciences.

Basketball Standout Turns Talent Scout

When Toronto Raptors forward Charlie Villanueva recently played in the 2006 T-Mobile Rookie Challenge during the NBA All-Star Weekend in Houston, nobody was prouder than former CCSU basketball standout Jim Kelly, and with good reason. Villanueva was one of nine rookies and 10 second-season pros picked to compete, solidifying Kelly's reputation as one of the NBA's finest evaluators of talent.

Villanueva was the Raptors' top draft pick in 2005, at Kelly's urging, and the former UConn star is averaging just under 12 points and just over five rebounds per game coming off the bench.

Kelly's choices continue to pay big dividends for the Canadian team, but, amid the turmoil of the 2003-2004 season that ended with both the general manager and head coach being fired, Kelly, the team's director of player personnel, was a "lame duck" as he prepared for the NBA draft.

As the search for a new GM dragged on, Kelly—and his inner circle, which includes other "Central guys," Bob Zuffelato '59 and Steve Young '73—simply came to work everyday and did his job knowing that the odds of his keeping that job under a new general manager were slim. "You just try to be as normal and consistent as possible," he told *Toronto Globe and Mail* sportswriter Michael Grange.

At the draft, where the Raptors had the number four pick, Kelly's choice of Georgia Tech's Chris Bosh was viewed as "disappointing," but Bosh is averaging 22.6 points per game and is the Raptors' best player.

Team management was so impressed with Kelly's loyalty, not to mention prescience, that they kept him on after the "regime change." He now has Zuffelato scouting the East Coast. Young, another former CCSU star, handles Europe.

Kelly has remained just as loyal to CCSU. "We probably speak about once a week on average," says Central Coach Howie Dickenman. "Despite an incredibly busy schedule, Jim always finds time to attend a (CCSU) game or practice every year." He and Zuffelato, who lives in Rhode Island, also attended a recent Hoop Group Luncheon.

Playing basketball as a student athlete at Central afforded me many opportunities that otherwise might never have been within my reach," says Beryl Piper. "For instance, after graduating, I spent a year playing professional basketball in Ireland, and the experience of living in another country and winning the National Cup with Team Blarney was priceless."

When Piper returned to the U.S., she spent a season coaching junior varsity basketball at Northwest Catholic High School in West Hartford, which gave her a chance to work with a state championship-winning team. agents, teachers and coaches. I love to hear from them and find out how, and what, they are doing," Piper says.

"As a physical education major and student athlete at Central, I spent a lot of time at the gym," she continues. "Central became my second family. I was fortunate to have teachers and coaches who not only were fun, but who worked together to help me succeed. They always made me feel important, and they were a positive influence on my decision to become a teacher and coach. I know that I am welcome at Central, and I have gone back for advice many times."

Piper has five older sisters and one younger, none of whom were able to attend college. "Central gave me a chance by offering me a scholarship, and the education I received prepared me to succeed as a teacher and coach," she says.

Piper feels a responsibility to give back to the program at CCSU so other students like her can have the same opportunity she had. "I believe in Central; it has so much to offer. I encourage all alumni to give so the University can continue to improve its educational and athletic offerings."
