NURSING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Acceptance to CCSU
- A minimum CCSU cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00.
- A minimum overall GPA average of 3.00 for all coursework taken at all institutions.

PRIOR to a student submitting their application to the nursing program, the following courses/criteria must be completed.

- Minimum grade of **C+ in BIOMOLECULAR SCIENCE 102/103**: Introduction to Biomolecular Science lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- Minimum grade of **C+ in CHEMISTRY 161/162**: General Chemistry I lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- Minimum adjusted individual total score of **70.0%** for the **TEAS VII test**. This test may be taken **ONLY 3 times** during a calendar year.

ENROLLED in at time of application but must be successfully completed by the end of the spring semester prior to enrolling in Nursing courses in the fall, the following courses/criteria must be completed.

- Minimum grade of **C+ in CHEMISTRY 210** Foundations of Organic Chemistry or equivalent
- Minimum grade of **C in PSYCHOLOGY 136** Life Span Development or equivalent
- A grade of C+ or better in any additional required science courses, if completed

APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 15th

The online application *typically* becomes available late December.

All application materials (application, official transcripts & TEAS Test scores) are due Feb. 15th.

Admission to the Nursing Program is highly competitive and meeting the following criteria does not guarantee admission.

Students will be ranked on the above criteria as follows:

25% overall GPA, 25% BMS 102/103 grades, 25% CHEM 161/162 grades, 25%
TEAS VII score
