## NURSING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Acceptance to CCSU
- A minimum CCSU cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00.
- A minimum overall GPA average of 3.00 for all coursework taken at all institutions.

**PRIOR** to a student submitting their application to the nursing program, the following courses/criteria must be completed.

- Minimum grade of C+ in BIOMOLECULAR SCIENCE 102/103: Introduction to Biomolecular Science lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- Minimum grade of C+ in CHEMISTRY 161/162: General Chemistry I lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- Minimum adjusted individual total score of **70.0%** for the **TEAS VII test**. This test may be taken ONLY 3 times during a calendar year.

**ENROLLED** in at time of application but must be successfully completed by the end of the spring semester prior to enrolling in Nursing courses in the fall, the following courses/criteria must be completed.

- Minimum grade of C+ in CHEMISTRY 210 Foundations of Organic Chemistry or equivalent
- Minimum grade of C in PSYCHOLOGY 136 Life Span Development or equivalent
- A grade of C+ or better in any additional required science courses, if completed

## APPLICATION DEADLINE: February 15th

The online application *typically* becomes available late December.

All application materials (application, official transcripts & TEAS Test scores) are due Feb. 15<sup>th.</sup>

Admission to the Nursing Program is highly competitive and meeting the following criteria does not guarantee admission.

Students will be ranked on the above criteria as follows: 25% overall GPA, 25% BMS 102/103 grades, 25% CHEM 161/162 grades, 25% TEAS VII score
