Potential for professional competence includes the following: grade point average of 2.5 or higher in major, satisfactory voluntary field evaluation(s), awareness of diversity and populations-at-risk, writing skills, and self-awareness. Each of these areas will be rated using a five-point scale. Scale: 5 = Excellent 4 = Very Good 3 = Good 2 = Fair 1 = Poor

An interview with the social work faculty admissions committee may be scheduled once the application, personal narrative, and portfolio are submitted and reviewed by faculty.
