

Planned Program of Graduate Study

The graduate planned program of study (GPPS) is an important document representing an official agreement between the student and the university, with the academic advisor. The GPPS lists the courses and other requirements that must be completed prior to program completion or graduation. The GPPS is not official until your academic signs and approve it and it is processed by the Registrar's office; it must be submitted before the completion of 15 course credits. (An earlier submission is recommended.) The official copy is retained in the student's university academic record. The GPPS must be revised for submission if changes are made and
